If you accidentally added an image to your collection that you don't want, just click the same button again to remove it. On a mobile device, tap the bookmark icon under the image. You will see that the icon has become solid blue when your device. After saving images from a Google image search to a collection, you can view it at any time by going to the and logging in with the same Google account you used to save the image. You have to be online to access your Google collection. You can access your Google collection from any browser on any device. There is no limit to how many images images can save on collections. Saved images can be removed from your collection at any time by taking the next steps. Open the Collection web page and log in. Click Select. Click on a small box, especially the images you want to remove from your collection. Click Delete. Confirm the deletion by clicking Delete. Khamosh Pathak WhatsApp automatically saves media in your gallery. This sounds like a good idea, but when you enter multiple groups, it can take up a lot of storage space. Here's how you can stop WhatsApp from automatically saving images. Stop WhatsApp from automatically saving images on your iPhone By default, all the photos and videos you receive are stored directly in the Camera Roll in the Photos app on your iPhone. To disable the feature, open the WhatsApp app and go to the Settings tab. Here's the Chats option. From this screen, click on the switch next to Save for the Roll camera to disable the auto-saving feature. Photos and videos will still be downloaded automatically on your iPhone, but they will remain in WhatsApp's memory. If you want to manually keep the media in the camera roll, open the photo or video and click on the Share button. Click here for Save. As we mentioned above, the WhatsApp app still uploads photos and videos, it's easy to keep them in your own app storage. But it can fold quickly. If you want to stop the media from downloading right at the source, go to the Settings tab and select the Use of Data and Storage option. Click here for Photos. From this screen switch to Never. Now you can do the same for audio, video and document sections as well. Now that you get any media, you'll see the Download button. Click on it to download the media. Stop WhatsApp from automatically saving images on Android The process for Android is a little different. Open the WhatsApp app and click on the three-point menu button from the top toolbar. Click here for Settings. Click Use data and store on the Settings page. In the Media Auto-Download section you will see three different options for mobile data, Wi-Fi and roaming. Go through each section and unobstructed photos, audio, video and documents options disable automatic downloading. If you want to enable an automatic download but don't want the media to appear in the Gallery app, you can do so from Chat in the settings. Click on the switch next to the Media Visibility option here. No more apps, games, Facebook, phone calls or browsing. It's all gone. But that's not all bad news. If you leave or the tablet is on, you will have problems. Turning it off immediately can just save the device. In fact, there are a few steps you can take to get water out of your tablet or phone and save it from destruction. Help! My tablet is wet and not turned on! It is important to act quickly when your phone or tablet is wet. Water and electricity just don't get along; The wet device can short and even give you an electric shock. Water can damage the screen and clear up in the frame, slots, under the screen and in the battery cavity. Basically, letting your phone or tablet get wet is a bad idea and requires you to act as quickly as possible. In short, stop trying to turn it on. You have to let the phone dry if you ever want it to work again. Dropped your phone or tablet in the water? Turn it off! If your phone has been exposed to enough water to make you concerned, the first thing you should do is turn it off! Meanwhile, if you're using a removable battery phone, open the compartment and blow out the battery. You can be out and about when the phone gets wet, or you can be at home or in the office. In any case, you will need to find a flat, dry surface that you can use for the next steps. Fast action is recommended---, to quickly complete the next steps will result in a permanently damaged phone or tablet! Fortunately, phones and tablets don't fall apart too easily. If they did, they'd probably fragment every time they were dumped! However, along with the battery, two other items can be removed: SIM card: get it, dry it with a paper towel, and keep it safe. Removable micro-SD map: Remove and dry the map. Please note that not all devices will have a removable SD card. The reason for this is simple--- everywhere! By removing these two cards, you can dry the slots with some paper cloth to soak the residual water. Drying your phone or tablet Don't stop at SIM card and SD card slots. Any water you can find on the off device should be washed away as quickly as possible. Make sure all water droplets on the edge of the display are absorbed. Also check around any screw holes and --- fact, everywhere on the outside of your phone or tablet. Not taking the device apart is as dry as you will be able to physically get it. Opening a phone or tablet is dangerous, by the way. You only end up persuading moisture to come into contact with the main board and other components. So, how do you dry out the insides of a phone or tablet that's wet? 4 Ways to get water from your phone or tablet Inside your smartphone or tablet you'll find processors, circuit boards, rocket buttons---all where water can find a home and cause damage. With the waterlogged device quickly shuts down both SIM and micro SD SD Removed, however, you are in a strong position to recover the device. You just need to dry the bare circuit board, wires and processors inside. 1. Boiler/ Airing a Cupboard heat-based solution, it will take a few hours to dry your phone--- probably about a full day. However, turn on the boiler before using this solution. 2. A bowl of rice While you may have to head to your local convenience store, a bowl of dry, raw rice is perhaps the most successful solution to any water damage to your phone or tablet. You will need to pack it in a container large enough to hold your equipment and a good layer of rice--- about 1 inch on all sides---no the food will soak up almost all the moisture at night, leaving you with a fully functioning device. 3. A lot of Silica gel do you collect these silica packs that ship with most electronic goods? Pack your phone or tablet in a box with lots of bags of silica gel to cover the device on all sides and leave it overnight and hope that your accumulation was not in vain. 4. Pure alcohol is the last suggestion that has been proven to work is the use of pure alcohol. If the damage caused to your device by water is the result of basic physics, the immersion of the device in alcohol is the result of basic chemistry. Alcohol displaces water, after which you remove the device from the liquid, alcohol evaporates. This is an extreme solution, but useful if other fixes don't work. Find a water-damaged pill repair service if none of the above works, or you can't find rice or even a warm place, consider repairing. While expensive (and perhaps a waste of time), some phone shops will have to deal with water damage. Own an iPad or iPhone? If you have Apple Care, this should cover you for two accidental damage incidents that includes water, so it's probably worth paying for Apple Care. For non-Apple devices, you need to check whether the damage is covered by the insurance you took with your phone or tablet. Don't throw your phone or tablet in the water! These fixes are only for extreme scenarios. Don't let your phone or tablet get wet! A few splashes of rain are in order; anything else could be catastrophic. These potential fixes are exactly this: potential fixes, as opposed to actual fixes. They have been shown to work, but none of them are guaranteed. So consider these safe practices: Don't use your phone or tablet over the toilet, sink or bathroom.
